### Vineyard

It comes from a 17ha vineyard, located next to the coast, where the River Plate estuary meets the Atlantic Ocean. Soils are formed of calcareous white and brown clays.

### Viticulture

Using no insecticide and dry no-till farming, the family practices sustainable farming. Minimal intervention viticulture. Hand harvested.

### Winemaking

Co fermented Nebbiolo & Tannat at 34°C for 7 days. The wine is aged in neutral French oak barrels for 6 months. Unfined.

### Tasting Notes

Medium bodied and a translucent cherry red in colour, the aromatics are true to varietal with some floral, dried rose petals nuances, along with spice and lifted red berry fruits.
