### Vineyard

Located next to the banks of the Mataquito River and about 25 kilometres away from the sea, amidst the pronounced slopes of the ancient coastal range, this site has different types of metamorphic soils such as licorella, shale, silty soil and some areas with loamy clay.

### Viticulture

Certified Sustainable.

Both the harvest of the bunches and the selection of the best grapes were carried out manually on selection tables, specially equipped to individually choose only the best grapes.

### Winemaking

Bunches destemmed, not crushed for astringency prevention. Fermentation in micro-tanks at 26-28 C for 7 days, followed by maceration. 100% aged in 225L French oak barrels (medium toast) for 10 months. 100% underwent malolactic fermentation.
